Week 1

Wed 1st - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Pray for Pytchen from HEAL Africa and his family as they mourn the death of his younger brother and cousin (both 27-years-old) in a car accident. May the Spirit of the Lord bring them comfort at this painful time.

Thu 2nd - UGANDA

Praise God that, after being held up by lockdown, the construction of the new Wakisa Centre has begun!

Fri 3rd - INDIA

Pray that God will keep BCM staff safe as they continue to serve their communities during this pandemic. Some lockdown restrictions have been lifted recently and there has been a surge in COVID-19 cases in the areas they work in.

Sat 4th - PHILIPPINES

Praise God for the PMF pastors who have been able to continue serving their congregation through online preaching. PMF churches in Batangas, Cavite and Laguna have been doing twice a day preaching through Facebook. Pray that in this time of quarantine many will come to know the Lord Jesus Christ.

Sun 5th - WORLDSHARE

Praise God for the generosity of our supporters during our EOFY campaign. Pray that, as final donations come in this week, we have met our financial goals for the year and can continue supporting all of the work of our ministry partners.

Mon 6th - UGANDA

Pray for CFM as they consider how to continue their evangelical outreach programs in these times. Even with some restrictions being lowered in Uganda, it looks like large group gatherings (like the large-scale outreach events CFM run) will be banned for some time still.

Tue 7th - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Pray for Decharte, a teacher at Ephphatha, who's 1-year-old child passed away suddenly. Pray for God's peace, comfort and healing for Decharte and his wife as they go through this tragic time.

Week 2

Wed 8th - UGANDA

Praise God that the locust plague that was ravaging rural communities in Uganda has passed. Pray for recovery efforts in those areas and for families who have lost their crops - their sources of food and livelihood.

Thu 9th - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Praise God for the doctor and nurses at the Ephphatha center who continue to provide care for the hearing impaired community despite the risks of COVID-19. Pray that God will keep them safe and well as they serve in this way.

Fri 10th - PHILIPPINES

Pray for Alfredo at PMF as he revises the School for Church Planters (SCP) curriculum to fit distance learning. Going forwards, once lockdown is over, pray that God blesses PMF's plans to expand the SCP program to train and equip many workers for mission work and church ministry.

Sat 11th - WORLDSHARE

Praise God for Rachel (our Community and Church Relationships Manager) who gave birth to a healthy happy girl last month. Praise God that everyone in the family is well and enjoying getting to know their newest addition.

Sun 12th - INDIA

Praise God that Satish, a 14-year-old local boy who ran away from home amidst the COVID-19 lockdown, has returned home safe.

Mon 13th - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Pray that the lockdown restrictions on church services, prayer meetings and other church related activities may be lifted as soon as possible in the DRC.

Tue 14th - UGANDA

Praise God for the safe delivery of babies for Alysha and Sarah at Wakisa, amidst the challenges of COVID-19 lockdown. Both mums and babies are doing well.

Week 3

Wed 15th - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Praise God for the recent installation of a second COVID-19 lab in Goma, which means that they are now able to get COVID-19 test results in four days instead of waiting for weeks to get results from Kinshasa (the DRC's capital city 2,500km away).

Thu 16th - UGANDA

Pray for the young mothers from Wakisa's sponsorship program, who have gone through so much to return to school and now are stuck at home in lockdown, not sure when they will be able to go back to school.

Fri 17th - AUSTRALIA

Pray for God's wisdom as we continue to work out how to best support our ministry partners as they serve their communities during this global pandemic.

Sat 18th - INDIA

Pray for students at BCM's Sinclairs School who are about to sit their grade 10 exams this month. Exams were supposed to happen in March but were postponed due to lockdown. Many of these students are nervous and distracted from the pandemic going on around them. Pray that God comforts and supports them at this time.

Sun 19th - PHILIPPINES

Pray for Bishop Felix Espura and his leadership team at PMF as they work out how to continue doing mission events and ministry work during lockdown.

Mon 20th - UGANDA

Pray for the mother of CFM's cook, Immaculate, who has been ill and was recently admitted to hospital. Pray for God's healing and provision over her.

Tue 21st - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Pray for Jacques, the driver at Ephphatha, whose mother passed away recently. Pray that God would comfort him and his family as they mourn their loss.

Week 4

Wed 22nd - UGANDA

Praise God for Martha who safely delivered her baby by caesarean after she was rushed to hospital with high blood pressure and seizures. Praise God that she is recovering well and has a happy healthy baby.

Thu 23rd - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Praise God for blessing Alice (a teacher at Ephphatha) and her husband Jean with a healthy happy baby. Pray that God will continue to look after and bless their family.

Fri 24th - INDIA

Pray for the father of two students of BCM's Sinclairs School, who is hoping to undergo treatment for a recently discovered brain tumour. Pray for God's healing and His comfort and provision for their family.

Sat 25th - PHILIPPINES

Pray for schools in the Philippines, in particular PMF's Elizabeth Academy, as they struggle with the logistics, costs and workload of transitioning to online teaching.

Sun 26th - AUSTRALIA

Praise God that with restrictions easing that many churches in Australia may be able to start meeting together again in person.

Mon 27th - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Pray for the 'street kids' that are members of HEAL's Uamusho Project. They're not allowed to meet during lockdown and there are concerns that some of them may go back to their former lives of begging and crime to survive.

Tue 28th - UGANDA

Pray for the regions of Uganda recently affected by floods. Many homes and important bridges were destroyed. Pray for good weather and God's blessing over the recovery and reconstruction efforts. Pray for the families who have lost so much at this time.

Week 5

Wed 29th - INDIA

Pray for the families who were not able to return home before India's strict lockdown came into effect and so have been stranded in other parts of the country away from home during this pandemic.

Thu 30th - UGANDA

Pray for the many families in rural Uganda who were already surviving hand-to-mouth before COVID-19 and who relied heavily on day labour to support their basic needs. Thousands of these families are now at risk of starvation during lockdown.

Fri 31st - THE WORLD

Pray for everyone who has lost loved ones over the past few months and been unable to come together to mourn their loss and celebrate their lives.
