### Wed 3rd - INDIA

Continue to pray for the two students of BCM's Sinclairs school whose father is receiving treatment after having a brain tumour removed. Continue to pray for his complete healing.

### Thu 4th - PHILIPPINES

Pray for PMF's child sponsorship co-ordinator Pastor Bernard Salawa. Pray for wisdom on how he can continue to communicate with the children and their parents in order to best support them in their studies.

### Fri 5th - AUSTRALIA

Praise God that churches are able to come together and worship again after the lockdowns of last year. May we continue to appreciate the blessing it is to freely and safely meet and worship together in this country.

### Sat 6th - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

### Sat 13th - UGANDA

Praise God for a young mother at Wakisa who is deaf and dumb. She recently had a healthy baby girl and has been resettled in a safe community that supports deaf and dumb people.

### Sun 14th - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Praise God for the recent baptism of Mr Jeans at Ephphatha. Pray that God will continue to strengthen and deepen his faith for years to come.

### Mon 15th - UGANDA

Pray for the member of Wakisa's team whose son is currently in hospital dealing with mental health issues. Pray that he will stabilise and God will strengthen her as she cares for him.

### Tue 16th - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Pray for Pastor Papy at Ephphatha who has been invited on an evangelistic mission in Uganda this month. Pray that God will protect him in his travels.

### Wed 17th - WORLDSHARE

Please pray for Dinuka (our finance and operations officer) and her young son Shaun, who is struggling to put on weight. Pray that God would heal Shaun's body and pour His peace and comfort over Dinuka and her family at this stressful time.

### Mon 22nd - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Praise God for the agriculture classes now available at the new Wakisa Centre. Praise God that they recently had their first harvest of vegetables.

### Sun 28th - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Pray for the teachers at Ephphatha as they incorporate new subject material about running a business into their vocational training courses. Pray that God blesses their efforts in teaching and the students' efforts to learn.
