Week 1

Fri 1st - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Pray for the upcoming elections for Bishop of North Kivu (following the passing of Dr Lévis Milegha Mbala). Pray that the new Bishop might also share God's heart for the region's vulnerable people, including the deaf.

Sat 2nd - UGANDA

Wakisa's security guard, Seki, recently passed away from COVID-19. Pray for God's comfort and peace over his family and everyone at Wakisa as they mourn.

Sun 3rd - INDIA

Pray for the vaccination program in India. The scarcity of vaccines has put pressure on hospitals, leading to reports of malpractice. Pray for BCM's staff who are due for their second dose in coming weeks, that they would receive it without trouble and stay safe.

Mon 4th - PHILIPPINES

Pray for the Philippines as COVID-19 cases continue to surge in Metro Manila and a number of provinces. Many people are sick but afraid to go to hospital, both because they can't afford treatment but also because of the greater risk of infection.

Tue 5th - WORLDSHARE

Praise God for all the people who responded to our recent request for volunteers.

Wed 6th - UGANDA

Praise God for CFM's field officer, Allan Angura, who rides out to Mafudu every day to support their locally-led agricultural project. Praise God for his commitment and pray for his continued safety.

Thu 7th - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Praise God for the success of the Mugunga school and for new opportunities to increase our support to the school through HEAL Africa.

Week 2

Fri 8th - UGANDA

Praise God for the 16-year-old mother at Wakisa, who despite the hardships of her ordeal (she fell pregnant after being sexually assaulted in her home) and the challenges of school during this pandemic, has just earned great exam results and graduated into high school, all while caring for her 6-week-old baby.

Sat 9th - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Pray for the HEAL team as they plan for a new outreach and evangelism project, which will provide reconciliation and trauma counselling in vulnerable communities

Sun 10th - PHILIPPINES

Praise God that the Philippine Government is doing a good job of rolling out paper-based remote learning for those that can't afford digital devices or access WiFi.

Mon 11th - CAMBODIA

Praise God that Sunshine's finance manager has healed from her knee injury to the point that she can now walk again without crutches.

Tue 12th - INDIA

Pray for wisdom and strong leadership for BCM's Primary School academic team as they navigate a new curriculum during this very difficult phase.

Wed 13th - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Pray that the construction of a baptism pool at the Ephphatha church is completed this month in time for the baptism of nine Ephphatha members.

Thu 14th - UGANDA

Pray that the government of Uganda can secure sufficient vaccines to vaccinate at least 22 million people (in line with the guidance from their National Planning Authority and Ministry of Health).

Week 3

Fri 15th - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Praise God that all 11 of Ephphatha's current vocation training students have been able to find internships despite the challenges of the pandemic.

Sat 16th - UGANDA

Pray for rain in Uganda. While the Mafudu agricultural project has been faring well, a delayed rainy season has seen many people (including some CFM sponsorship families) lose essential crops.

Sun 17th - WORLDSHARE

Praise God for John Lamerton (a member of WorldShare's Board) who has begun working with WorldShare Connect to foster new partnerships.

Mon 18th - INDIA

Pray for BCM's sponsorship coordinator Solomon, who has been repeatedly falling sick in recent weeks since recovering from COVID-19.

Tue 19th - CAMBODIA

Praise God that Mr. Sem Sochetra's (Sunshine's Executive Director) health has been a bit better recently. He has been suffering from unexplained dizziness for over a year now. Continue to pray for complete healing from the Lord.

Wed 20th - UGANDA

Pray that the young mothers in Wakisa's sponsorship program would keep safe and stay focused on their studies while locked-down at home.

Thu 21st - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Pray for the hunger crisis in the DRC. As a result of the ongoing civil conflict and the economic effects of the COVID-19 pandemic over 27 million people are facing acute hunger with 6.7 million of them on the cusp of famine.

Week 4

Fri 22nd - UGANDA

Praise God that Wakisa's vegetable garden has been able to help feed them these past months while in lockdown. Pray that the rainy season would come soon so everything can continue to grow well.

Sat 23rd - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Continue praying for Ephphatha's plans to open a University for the deaf. They have been held up by the pandemic, the rising violence and unrest in Goma, and the recent volcanic eruption. Pray that God would bless their efforts and that they may come to fruition in the new year.

Sun 24th - INDIA

Pray for the children of BCM's Child Care Centre. They have been stuck at home since the pandemic began last year. Teachers from the centre visit them in their homes to provide meals and support, but pray that the children can soon get back to socialising with friends and other children.

Mon 25th - CAMBODIA

Pray for the families in Sunshine's sponsorship program as they try to keep their income generating activities and small business going to support their families through tough times in this pandemic.

Tue 26th - PHILIPPINES

Praise God for the opening of a new School for Church Planters (SCP) Center in Bailen. It was started by Mel Abuyuan, an SCP graduate who wanted members of his church to study with PMF.

Wed 27th - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Pray that God would bless Ephphatha's project to translate the bible into Congolese sign language.

Thu 28th - UGANDA

Pray for the CFM churches, and all the churches in Uganda, during this latest lockdown. Pray that they can survive not being able to meet together in person and that they might even come out of it stronger than ever.

Week 5

Fri 29th - INDIA

Continue praying for the staff at BCM, most of them have lost people close to them during India's horrific COVID-19 second wave. May God give them His peace and comfort.

Sat 30th - DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Pray that God would bring peace to Goma (where our partners serve). Residents live under a constant threat of violence, kidnapping and death from rebel militia forces in the region.

Sun 31st - UGANDA

Praise God for the 10 girls at Wakisa who have accepted Jesus as their saviour in recent months.
